

STARTERS

Demolition \$5,000-\$6,000

We are planning on doing the demo work ourselves to save on this expense.

Permits / Insurance / Bond \$4,000-\$5,000

Foundation/Concrete/Masonry \$3,000-\$4,000

This includes cinder block and other masonry work on walls and floors.

ENTREES

Cabinetry \$35,000-\$38,000

All wood painted upper cabinets and one large full height storage cabinet.

Flooring \$15,000-\$17,000

Floor prep (shot blasting) and installation of new epoxy resin flooring able to withstand high traffic; easier to keep clean than tile.

A gift of \$30 will pay for one square foot of flooring.

Stainless Steel Counters & Shelves

\$40,000-\$45,000

All stainless steel lower countertops and shelving, cleaning capability aligns with commercial kitchen standards.

A gift of \$175 will pay for one square foot of counter/shelving.

Ceiling / Lighting \$8,000-\$9,000

New drop ceiling with commercial grade tiles and LED lighting.

Electrical \$7,500-\$8,000

This includes power, the fire alarm system, etc.

Mechanical \$9,000-\$10,000

This includes plumbing, HVAC, hood controls, drains, etc.

DESSERT & FINISHING TOUCHES

Dish Washing Machine \$5,000-\$7,000

Commercial dish machine will clean a load in 60 seconds, making cleaning up after large events and meals in The Shepherd's Market more efficient.

Ice Machine \$6,000-\$7,000

Large capacity ice maker meets needs for churchwide functions.

Warmer \$3,000-\$4,000

Vertical warmer keeps food warm for receptions, potlucks, churchwide events and serving meals in The Shepherd's Market.

Window Shades \$3,000-\$4,000

New roll-up shades for pass-through openings by sink into the Family Life Center and to The

Shepherd's Market.

Painting \$7,000-\$9,000

Industrial grade paint to withstand commercial kitchen wear and tear.

FOOD PANTRY SIDES

Ceiling / Lighting \$9,000-\$11,000

Similar scope as kitchen: New drop ceiling with commercial grade tiles and LED lighting.

Flooring \$19,000-\$21,000

Similar scope as kitchen but more square feet of floor to prep and install: Floor prep (shot blasting) and installation of new epoxy resin flooring able to withstand high traffic; easier to keep clean than tile.

A gift of \$30 will pay for one square foot of flooring.

Painting \$8,000-\$10,000

Similar scope as kitchen.
