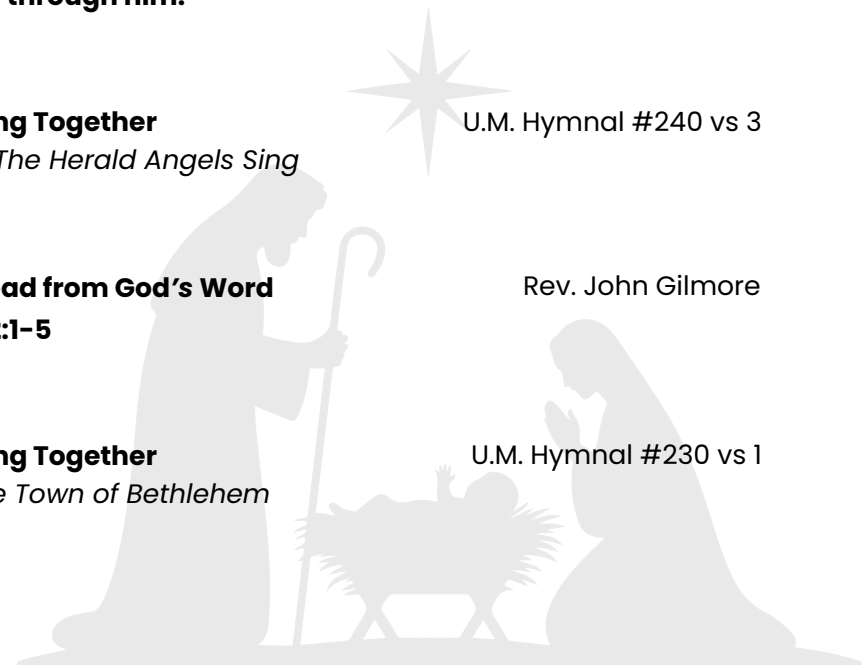
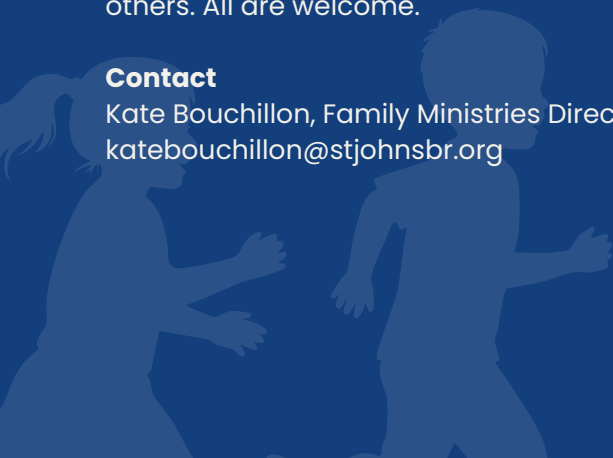

THE SHEPHERD'S MARKET

Our client-choice pantry provides meals and groceries to families in our neighborhood and beyond. Guests shop with a grocery cart, enjoy a hot meal, and can access a free library. This volunteer-powered ministry offers nourishment, dignity, and care to the wider community.

WHEN & WAYS TO SERVE

- Mondays: 3:30–5:30 p.m.
- Tuesdays & Thursdays: 8:00–10:00 a.m.
- Deliveries: 2nd & 4th Fridays, 8:00 a.m.

Volunteer roles include pantry assistants, intake, stocking, kitchen help, and sorting deliveries.

DONATIONS & SUPPORT

We collect food and household items on the first Sunday of each month (Grocery Bag Sunday). Learn more and make monetary donations at shepherdsmarket.org.

OUR IMPACT & STATS (2025)

- Total pounds distributed: 319,568
- Households served per month: ~400 (about 1,700 people)
- Average pounds per household: 57.56
- Supported by ~20 volunteers per shift
